Resources Clay tools, boards, hessian, cutters, slip, damp teatowels, old pencils, rolling pins, shape templates paper clips sponges to dampen clay.

National Curriculum Links/Learning:

To use a range of materials creatively to design and make products.
To use drawing to share their ideas.
To develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour shape, form..
To know how to make their own slip and use it to join pieces together, when using relief techniques.
To select appropriate materials for texture.
To be able to roll a consistent tile.
To understand that clay dries out the more you handle it and water can be used to help prevent this.

Prior Learning:

Manipulating clay- rolling flattening, using cutters, slip to join two shapes,
Thumb pot with playdough.
Rolling making balls, rolling etc

Activities/Teaching

Following work on The creation in R.S use the architectural relief on Salisbury's Cathedral as a stimulus. Design their own tile talk about not making things too small or complicated. Think about shape and images. Link back to knowledge of printing and texture. Explore session for texture in clay add to their plan.

Make own tile show how to roll between two pieces of wood or books to make an even tile. Don't forget to turn the clay tile like you would with pastry!

What shape tile? Circular, oval square, rectangle? Use template to cut around use blunt knives.

Remind about scoring of both surfaces (can use an old toothbrush) and use of slip to join. Sponges for dampening clay if it starts to dry out too quickly. Relief -adding onto the tile, carving -cutting into the tile- remind not to dig too deep!

Paperclip to hang tile

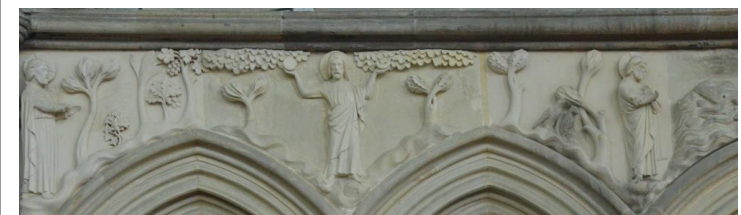
Think about background texture. How will they create patterns and markings? Selecting tools and everyday objects.

Drying time then decorating. Cover in white paint and dry. Refer to their design when painting. Glaze with pva.
